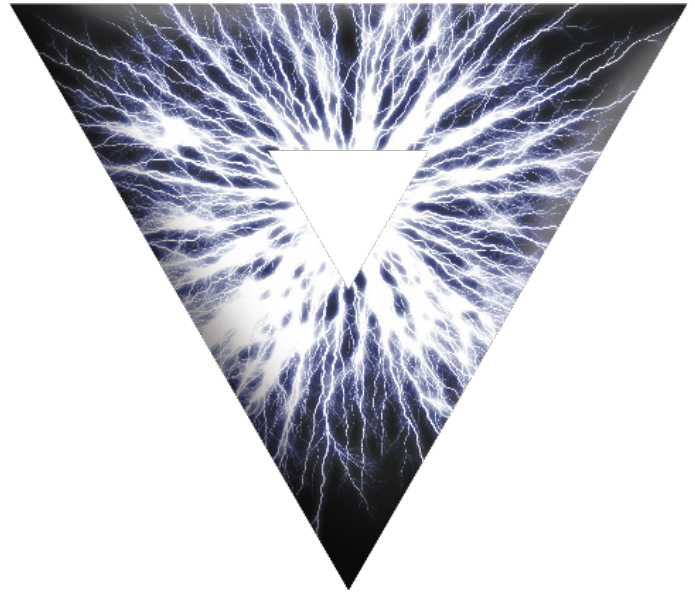


# Australasian Rehabilitation Nurses' Association Member Scholarship Program



The University of Tasmania and the Australasian Rehabilitation Nurses' Association (ARNA) have partnered to offer postgraduate nursing courses on a scholarship basis to ARNA members.

As a member of the ARNA, under the Member Scholarship Program, you can study a Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma in Nursing, specialising in Rehabilitation Nursing with the University of Tasmania – and receive a full scholarship on your HECS fees (subject to eligibility).

Our postgraduate nursing courses are designed for practicing nurses who would like to specialise in a particular field of healthcare, and are suitable for nurses in various stages of their career.

With a program that is flexible, part time and online, you can advance your nursing career while maintaining a work and family life balance.

Under the ARNA Member Scholarship Program, you will be enrolled into the Bachelor of Nursing with **Professional Honours (H4F)**, and will be able to graduate with either a Graduate Certificate in Nursing (Specialisation H5F), or a Graduate Diploma in Nursing (Specialisation H6F).

## Bachelor of Nursing with Professional Honours (H4F)

<b>LOCATION</b>	<b>Distance (Online)</b>
<b>DURATION</b>	<b>2 years part-time (max 5 years) various exit points</b>

Whilst undertaking this course, you will need access to a relevant healthcare setting in a rehabilitation nursing environment.

All postgraduate nursing courses are offered on a part time basis only, allowing you to balance your work and study commitments, and study successfully at postgraduate level.



## Entry Requirements

In order to apply for the BN Professional Honours (H4F), you will need to be a Registered Nurse in Australia, and have had at least six months full time experience in relevant nursing practice within the last five years.

To be eligible for the ARNA Member Scholarship Program, you need to be a current financial member of ARNA for the duration of the course. Proof of membership will be required upon application.

To receive a member scholarship, you will need to apply for the Bachelor of Nursing with Professional Honours, course code H4F. If you apply into any program other than H4F, you will not receive a member scholarship and course fees will apply.
